-Next came our yearly "ringing the bells" especially the big one, for the Salvation Army. This turns out to be a favorite of several of the brothers. See more information below.



Past Master Highlight Bernard Jacob Steffes 1938

Bernard Jacob Steffes was born March 11, 1908 in Naperville, DuPage County, Illinois the son of Theodore Jacob Steffes and Mary Lies. He was employed by his father at T. J. Steffes Plumbing and Heating Contractors in Naperville, then as a core maker at a foundry in Aurora, Illinois and later as a transit weight inspector in Macon County, Illinois and Cleveland, Ohio. He married Marjorie Garrison about 1936 and they were the parents of two children, David and Mary Ann. He was raised a Master Mason June 18, 1929 and served the Lodge as Master in 1938. His father, Theodore, and brother, Francis, were also members of Euclid Lodge. He was employed by the Ohio Inspection and Weights Bureau in Cleveland Ohio when he died, January 8, 1945. He was buried in the Lake Street Memorial Park, Elgin, Kane County, Illinois with members of Euclid Lodge performing the Masonic Funeral Ceremony.


This award was named after Frank C. Roundy who was the 10th Potentate of Medinah and became the first Past Potentate of Medinah to become an Imperial Potentate.
